The island uses the 'Fly' kitchen in dark stained Oak veneer with a dramatic 30mm Nero Assoluto worksurface and integrated sink. The cupboards on the back wall, concealing both high-tech appliances and dedicated storage, are from the 'Blade' collection in Graphite Aluminium.
