The awkward space
The biggest challenge and main part of the brief for this kitchen was creating enough storage while dealing with the shape of the room. The creatives at Designspace London were asked to ensure that as much of the space was used as possible - but the units and worktops had to be comfortable to use. Not only that, everything also had to look coordinated with the sloped ceiling. This was achieved by matching the height of the island to the beginning of the elevation as well as designing and constructing the cupboards to perfectly work with the angle of the roof. Good preparation and worktop space were also essential, so a long island, housing both the hob and the sink, was included which means most of the cooking can be done facing into the room rather than looking at a wall. However, placement was key - so the hob now sits as far away from the sloped ceiling as possible for ease of use. >

The PLANS

Because of the sloping ceiling the position of key appliances had to be carefully planned to make them comfortably useable.
